 - Postmark Brewing meeting (Nate and Steve of Postmark)- beef is a prominent member of the beer scene airing their grievances about Postmark publicly.
 - They have been offering a CAMRA discount without our knowledge because they want to support us so we'd like to work closely with them in the future
 - CAMRA and Callister Brewing
 - Any issue with a Callister Cask at WVBF?
 - Could that be a conflict of interest with a past president's brewery?
 - Consensus not feeling like that's a problem at all

- Vanbrewer awards and CAMRA Sponsorship
 - Been doing it for 5 years no issues.
 - Sponsorship should be under the budget an opportunity to support future brewers
 - Danny's suggestion: Donating a pin to second place winners?
 - David wants all of us to hold each other accountable for processing items such as this communication is key!

 - ii. Problems with Golden Spike Days and exclusion of YD / Moody (who puts this on? City councillor calls the shots - Jeremy has got the name)
 - issues with being included; Golden Spike only wants to deal with Whistler Brewery (no one else is allowed to serve beer except for Whistler brewing)

- Looking for some guidance to handle this properly
- They should let the community know; let the people of Port Moody make the decision. CAMRA can't take a stance officially, members of the community should be a part and take a stand.
- Ari is happy to reach out to the community and clarify what exactly it is that we do.

New merch costs - \$390.65 for 48 t shirts - waiting for payment from SO for rest of that order \$8.14 each (sell our shirts for \$20 each)
